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Accessing our portal online

HTTPS://PACS.THERADIOLOGYCLINIC.COM.AU/PORTAL

Our online portal is a quick link to our PACS system. This means you only need to open your internet browser and save the website to your browser favourites.

You can copy and paste the URL above in the search bar of your preferred internet browser and click enter.

This should bring you to the following log-in page.



If you **do not have an existing account**, you are able to apply for one on this page. If you do have an account, please enter your username and password here.

The first time you log in, you will be required to accept the privacy conditions. You will need to do this using the internet portal prior to logging in using the Inteleviewer program.

Confidentiality Agreement

I accept full responsibility for the personal identification and password codes issued to me for access to The Radiology Clinic's computerised Radiological Image and Patient Information System. In order to protect the confidentiality of the information to which I am now party. I agree that:

- 1. The Radiology Clinic's computing facilities are to be used for authorised purposes and in the support of The Radiology Clinic approved activities only.
- 2. I will not attempt to access information in The Radiology Clinic's computer system which is not required by my day to day responsibilities. Browsing through patient records or accessing records that are not required is strictly prohibited.
- 3. The personal identification and password codes are assigned to me only and I must not share them with others. I will take all reasonable precautions to protect the privileges assigned to me. If I have any reason to believe that another person is aware of my password, I will immediately change it.
- I will not attempt to access or alter information in the Hospital computer system by using any user or group identification codes other than my own.
- I will not permit another person to access or alter information in The Radiology Clinic's computer system under my personal identification code, after I have logged on the system.
- 6. It is my responsibility to logout of the system when my work is complete or when I leave my station for a period of time.
- It is my responsibility to report incidences of improper and/or illegal activities which include using The Radiology Clinic's facilities for abusive and/or malicious communications. Such reports must be made immediately to your supervisor or directly to the administration.
- I understand my responsibility for respecting patient's privacy and protecting the confidentiality of information to which I have access.

Add our server into your existing Inteleviewer program

A server bookmark is a quick link to an organisation's PACS system. This means you only need to download InteleViewer once onto your system where you can bookmark multiple organisations PACs servers.

1. Open the InteleViewer program on your computer

- 2.Click on "Edit Bookmarks"
- 3.In the top right-hand corner, click "Add"
- 4.Complete the fields as below, then click OK.

- 5. Click OK to save to Bookmark
- 6.You are now ready to enter your username and password.



Installing Inteleviewer for the first time

1. Go to pacs.theradiologyclinic.com.au/InteleViewer/

2. Click on the relevant download link for your system.

If you are unsure whether your PC is 32-bit or 64-bit, open your settings which is found in the start menu. Select "system" and then "about" to look up the "system type"

3. Read and agree to terms and conditions and accept default settings.

4. The InteleViewer icon should now appear on your desktop. Double click to launch.

5. The first time you open it, there will be no server bookmarks saved.

A server bookmark is a quick link to an organisation's PACS system. This means you only need to download InteleViewer once onto your system where you can bookmark multiple organisations PACs servers.

6. Select "enter a new server" and complete the fields as below, then click OK.

The 'Break-Glass' feature is an instant way to access patient images and reports without being the original requesting practitioner. This is available on both the InteleViewer and InteleConnect portals.

InteleViewer Breakglass:

1. Open InteleViewer on your computer and login to The Radiology Clinic's bookmark.

- 2. On the right, click "Break-Glass access"
- 3. Read and accept the terms of confidentiality

4. Search for the patient as you normally would. This can be the patient's name AND date of birth OR The Radiology Clinics patient ID number if this is known.

5. Then click "search".

If the patient exists on our database, they will appear.

6. Click "Access Patient Studies". This may take a few moments, then the examinations for the patient should appear.

Intelebrowser Breakglass:

1.Go to the InteleConnect webportal (https://pacs.theradiologyclinic.com.au) and login

2.Click on the padlock icon to the right of the search bar

3.Read and accept the terms of confidentiality

4.Enter the patient's name and date of birth, or The Radiology Clinic patient ID number

5.Click "Check Patient"

If the patient exists on our database, they will appear below.

6.Click "Access Patient Studies"

This may take a few moments, then the examinations for the patient should appear.
